

**AVID Property Group**  
**Waterford Mother's Day competition**  
**24 April 2026**  
**Conditions of Entry (Conditions)**

- 1 Information about prizes and how to enter the Carolina Easter Colouring Competition (**Competition**) forms part of these Conditions.
- 2 By entering, Entrants accept these Conditions. Nothing in these Conditions restricts, excludes or modifies or purports to restrict, exclude or modify any statutory consumer rights under any applicable law including the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* (Cth).
- 3 **Promoter** means AVID Residential Estates Pty Ltd (ACN 054 228 929) and its related entities.
- 4 The promotion begins at 10am (AEST) on 24 April 2026 and closes at 5pm (AEST) on 8 May 2026 (**Promotion Period**).

**Eligibility**

- 5 Entry is open only to Australian residents aged 12 years or under, and with the consent of their parent or guardian who live in the "Waterford" community (**Entrant**).
- 6 One entry per child is permitted.
- 7 Directors, management and employees of the Promoter, its associated companies or agencies as well as the immediate families of each of these people are not eligible to enter.

**How to enter**

- 8 To enter, the Entrant must:
  - (a) During the Promotion Period, create and submit a drawing of their mum together with their full name, their mum's full name, street address, mobile and email address and submit it to the Waterford Sales Team in person at the Waterford Sales & Information Centre at 2 Settlers Blvd, Chisholm.
  - (b) Attend the Waterford Mother's Day morning Tea at the Waterford Sales and Information Centre on **10 May 2026 at 11.00am**.
- 9 This competition is a game of chance and the winner will be determined by a random draw by the Promoter.
- 10 Entries must be received by the Promoter during the Promotion Period.
- 11 The Promoter may accept or reject an entry in its absolute discretion. No correspondence will be entered into with any Entrant whose entry has been rejected. The Entrant has no right of appeal or contest.

### **Entrant's responsibilities**

- 12 Entries that are found to have been derived from third party work will be considered invalid and, if awarded a prize, that prize must be returned to the Promoter.
- 13 The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any damage, injury, loss, defect, interruption, destruction, personal or property damage, third party damage, or theft which may occur as a result of entry into this Competition.
- 14 Failure to comply with the Conditions may lead to immediate disqualification of an entry and withdrawal of prizes.
- 15 The Competition is designed to encourage community participation and the spirit of giving and sharing. Entrants agree to enter the Competition in the spirit in which it was intended and act accordingly.

### **Drawing the Winner**

- 16 The Promoter reserves the right to disqualify or withdraw an entry at any time if these Conditions are not complied with.
- 17 The winner will be determined on Mother's Day **Sunday, 10 May 2026 between 11am – 11.30am** at the Waterford Sales and Information Centre during the Waterford Mother's Day morning tea.
- 18 The winner must be present to collect their prize on the day, 10 May 2026. In the event of a prize not being accepted or claimed within this time, the winner will be taken to have forfeited their prize and a redraw will be conducted.
- 19 The Promoter may require a winner to verify their entry and may require a winner or their nominee to provide proof of identity, age, purchase or residency. Proof considered suitable for verification is at the Promoter's discretion. Failure to provide any of this verification to the Promoter upon request may, at the Promoter's discretion, invalidate any or all of the Entrant's entries.
- 20 If a winning entry is deemed not to comply with these Conditions, the entry will be discarded.

- 26 The Promoter reserves the right to verify the validity of entries and to disqualify any entry which, in the opinion of Promoter, tampers with the entry process not in accordance with these Conditions or who has, in the opinion of Promoter, engaged in conduct in entering the Competition which is fraudulent, misleading, deceptive or generally damaging to the goodwill or reputation of the Competition and/or Promoter. The Promoter reserves the right to disqualify a winner if the Promoter becomes aware that the winner and/or the winner's entry is of a type described in this clause.
- 27 The Promoter reserves the right to request winners provide proof of identity, proof of residency or proof that they reside in the Waterford development.
- 28 The Promoter reserves the right to refuse an entry if it does not meet the entry criteria or is deemed offensive or inappropriate.
- 29 By entering the Competition the Entrant and their parent or legal guardian unconditionally gives the Promoter and any of its contractors and agents, the right to:
- a. take photographs and videos of any colouring page entries; and
  - b. to use any photos and videos of the entry to the Competition,
